
OHIO MARCH FOR LIFE October 4, Ohio Statehouse

Yes, we will have enemies! We are NEVER to panic or tremble before them because our confidence and faith is in God. I encourage you to read the whole chapter of Deuteronomy 20; it is only 20 verses long. God gives
