

#### PATHWAYS OF THE SEAS

Joshua 1:8 encourages us to meditate on God's Word day and night. We must never underestimate what God can reveal to us by His divine intervention. Matthew Maury, (1806-1873) a naval officer, while on shore, suffered a serious injury that resulted in permanent lameness. During an illness, Psalm 8 was being read to him by a family member. He asked that verse 8 be read to him again and again as he pondered the scripture, "...whatever passes through the paths of the seas." He concluded that if God said there were paths in the seas, there must be paths in the sea. With that in mind, he set out to find "the paths of the seas". Matthew learned that there definitely were pathways at certain locations in the ocean where

current flowed much the water ships sailed ocean their sailing be greatly collecting the sailing ships



faster than around it. If on these currents time could reduced. By itineraries of and their

travel times, he was able to chart these "pathways of the seas". His charts revolutionized naval travel around the world. Maury also investigated and discovered paths in the air, now known as jet streams. Besides mapping the currents of the seas and the air, he helped found the U.S Naval Academy, and was instrumental in laying the telegraph cable across the Atlantic. Matthew Maury recognized throughout his life that God's hand was upon him as he pioneered so many scientific breakthroughs. With God's Word, all things are possible!
