


KID'S KORNER


ESSEX & ASSOCIATES

Is it any wonder that in the Hebrew Bible there are so many names for God. What words could one find in any language to describe a Holy Sovereign God who created everything? There are not enough parts of speech to do God justice in proclaiming who He is. We are totally inadequate to honor the Creator of all things. Thankfully, He Himself knows our frame and that we are but dust. We may often perceive that "fearing God" has a negative

connotation, but it certainly doesn't. Here are many Scriptural examples of the BENEFITS of reverencing the Judge of all the earth. If you sow "the fear of the LORD" to the Eternal Perfect One, you will reap benefits in this life and eternally.

Benefits of fearing the Lord

Ps. 115:13; He will bless those who fear the LORD, the small together with the great.

Prov. 22:4; The reward of humility and the fear of the LORD are riches, honor and life.

<u>Prov. 19:23</u>; The fear of the LORD leads to life, so that one may sleep satisfied, untouched by evil.

<u>Ps. 85:9</u>; Surely GOD's salvation is near to those who fear Him, that glory may dwell in our land.

Ps. 147:11; The LORD favors those who fear Him, those who

wait for His lovingkindness.

Malachi 4:2; But for you who fear My name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings; and you will go forth and skip about like calves from the stall.

Ps. 25:14; The LORD confides in those who fear Him, and reveals His covenant to them.

<u>Ps. 37:4</u>; The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear Him and rescues them.

<u>Ps. 34:9</u>; Fear the LORD, you His saints, for those who fear Him lack nothing.

Job 28:28; The fear of the LORD, that is wisdom, and to shun evil is understanding.

<u>Prov. 10:27</u>; The fear of the LORD prolongs life, but the years of the wicked will be shortened.

The Words of the Living God are always beneficial to meditate on. The one thief crucified with Jesus, in his dying moments, received salvation because of his "fear of God". He recognized his sinfulness and Jesus' sinlessness. The best he hoped for was to be remembered by Jesus when He came into His Kingdom.
